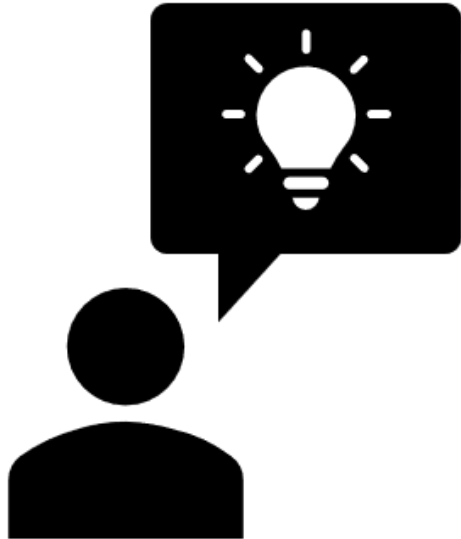
We strengthen the voice of Canadians, patients and caregivers by advocating for enhanced health policy and increased investment in health research

- Bring a unique lived experience to the discussion
- Providing patient reported outcome measures (real world evidence)
- Gain new insights into research design, implementation and evaluation
- Build extended disease/condition specific networks
- Advance knowledge translation of research impacts
- Shared sense of purpose

What Are the Expectations for the New Drug or What Experiences Have Patients Had With the New Drug?

Based on NO experience using the drug:

Is it expected that the lives of patients will be improved by this new drug, and how?

Is there a particular gap or unmet patient need in current therapy that this drug will help alleviate?

Would patients be willing to experience serious adverse effects with the new therapy if they experienced other benefits from the drug?

How much improvement in the condition would be considered adequate? What other benefits might this drug have — for example, fewer hospital visits or less time off work?

Meaningful Engagement



Individuals with lived experience are involved as a core member of decision making bodies



Patient evidence provided into the review is given serious consideration in the overall weighting of reviews



Patients are recognized as the experts in being able to provide real world evidence on the outcomes, impacts and quality of life perspective of taking a new drug



Patient representatives will receive the same reimbursement for their participation as other members of the review team



Patients are involved from the beginning in setting research priorities
